Qualitative Research

- Sought out participants personal understanding and description of PS1 and art in Iowa City.
 - Falls under interpretivist paradigm
 - Everyone will have different answers based on their unique consciousness
 - Subjective answers that represent different world views
 - Difficult to code (will discuss later in presentation)

Beginning Stages

- Met with Travis
 - General premise of project
- Traveled to PS1
 - Determined organization needs and desires through conversations with John and Kalmia
 - Translated into methodology for research
 - Created scientific and systematic approach to questions
 - Articulated questions designed to provide PS1 with pertinent information about the general public

Interviews (Purposive Sampling)

- Iowa City Gallery Walk (October)
 - Field Sites
 - Public Space 1
 - Glassando
 - Ten Thousand Villages
- Collected necessary data through semi-structured interviews
 - Were looking for a greater level of depth of information rather than number of participants.
 - Goal of 10 interviews per person
- Conducted interviews until we reached data saturation

Listening

- Assigned new ones each week to analyze

A lot of people said yes, but as we continued through the interview, they were unclear of the specific function PS1 had, or confused the organization with another entity (Television Station, Church, gaming console, etc)

Examples of findings

- People confuse PS1 for the church
- They don't know where to locate it
- People want to say "yes" when you ask them if they've heard of something so they'll lie to make you feel better. -- further questioning revealed that they do not know what PS1 is.
- Sometimes they heard of it but don't participate
 - Possible reasons: don't have time, location (they live far or can't find PS1 home base), disinterest in what is offered
- Most people had no idea they have printmaking tools available for use
- Large portion of general population participate by viewing, not doing art
- Thought of as more of a charity than a place for people to have access to art



Examples of findings

- Talent keeps them from making visual art
- Cost and Time commitments
- Busy because of work
- Distance, they don't want to leave home
- They didn't hear about the specific event
- Aren't interested in what's being offered

 - Leading questions
 - Asking the wrong things

• Qualitative Research can be difficult

- Having to decide when saturation was met
- Listening to many files was monotonous
- Artistic jargon is typically interpretive rather than definitive
- Staying on track & not jumping ahead

Moving Forward

- Figure out a way to differentiate PS1 from the church
- Ask the community what types of programs they would be interested in attending -- takes out the guesswork, more likely for people to attend because they feel responsible for part of an event's creation
