

We provide humane care to all animals needing protection, seek suitable homes for animals without owners and provide euthanasia when only medically or behaviorally necessary."

The Need for Care

Today, there is one wild cat to every owned, household cat in America. We recognize the seriousness of this issue and have taken action to improve public health and safety by taking animals off the streets within Washington and its surrounding areas.

Our main purpose is to help reduce overpopulation and abandonment in Washington, lowa and its surrounding communities. Uncontrolled breeding and irresponsible pet ownership contribute to the nearly 8-10 million animals United States shelters take in each year. As a part of our services, we help diminish the number of euthanized pets in the U.S. (about 4-6 million) every year.

As spring brings in dozens of litters of kittens and puppies, our care is needed now more than ever. Funds are needed to provide food, shelter, and medical care to these baby animals until they are adopted. This includes the building improvements and equipment necessary to continue providing a high level of care.

Making a Difference

We take in 700 animals every year for an average stay of 30 days each with an adoption rate of 76%. We have found 550 'forever homes' for animals in our care since we began our partnership with Petco for mobile adoption events in 2010.

Services we provide include:

- Adoption
- Animal Control and Rescue
- Spaying and Neutering (Including Trap-Neuter-Release Services)
- · Education and Outreach

 - o Bite Prevention Classes
 - o Pet Therapy

Over the last five years, we have worked on multiple construction projects to ensure the highest quality of housing for our animals. These projects have been completed slowly and in small increments due to high costs and lack of funding.

Why Is Funding Important?

Running our shelter costs \$165-175,000 each year. While we do get supplemental funding from the city and grants — along with raising funds ourselves through animal services, fundraising events, and adoption fees — most of this income is put toward building maintenance, insurance, and staff salary expenses. We still need \$20,000 in donations every year to break even. This is why any donation, big or small, is crucial in our ability to change and save the lives of animals in our community.





Sophie is endearingly known as our "Broken Pelvis Girl." She was hit by a car, but thankfully, after vet care and a lot of TLC from her wonderful foster parents, she's ready to become a permanent family member.

Bugsy required a lot of extra care. He had so many fleas and ticks (even maggots) in his horribly matted hair. He was severely anemic due to the infestation and starvation. Through medication, special food, and care, Bugsy fought his way back to good health. He's since found the love of a new mom and four kids who enjoy spoiling him!


