



Background of the Issue

 Bondurant population doubled from 2010 to present

- Bondurant faces a **critical** sustainability crossroads
 - Current actions affect future growth



Current State of the Issue

Tree Board Committee (Local)

- Consists of 5 members
- Care and maintenance of trees
- Suggests locations for the planting of new trees



Sustainability Initiatives (County)

- Educates communities on Environmental issues
- Meets Bi-monthly
- Registration required, but is free

Policy Recommendation: Sustainability Commission

Educate Residents

- Reduce personal environmental impact
- Promote environmental conservation and practices

Commission Foundation

- 2 city officials, 1 resident
- 4-year term, unpaid
- Additional seats dependent on population
 - Increases in multiples of 3



Policy Recommendation: Increase planting of trees and native grasses



Plant more trees near parks and on city streets

- Shaded roads save 60% of repaving costs
- One tree can reduce stormwater runoff by 845 gallons annually
- Provide shade in parks, promote mental wellbeing



Utilize low maintenance grasses

- Save \$ with less fertilizer, mowing, and watering costs
- Stay green longer and survive in harsher conditions



Create prairie strips

- 1/10th acre from farmland to prairie = \$26-33/year
- Helps prevent flooding
- Reduces sediment and nutrient runoff by more than 90%
- Habitat for birds and pollinators

Policy Recommendation: City Plan



Develop a green municipal building standard like LEED

- Build new city campus in accordance to standards
- LEED certification is unnecessary and expensive (~\$58,250 for campus)

Power city buildings with renewables


- Solar array at civic campus: 2 acres, 32,375 kWh/day, \$56,000-\$87,000
- Mixed use land?

Create an electric city fleet


- EGO Power+ Z6 Electric Mower: \$7000
- Transition vehicle fleet alongside infrastructure development

Next Steps for the City of Bondurant


Hold a meeting to plan the sustainability commission and get input from community
