Follow a Yearlong IISC Partnership

We are thrilled to share a<u>new</u> <u>ArcGIS StoryMap</u> showcasing the process and accomplishments from our recent yearlong partnership with the City of Manchester. If you are a potential community partner, curious faculty member, or UI administrator, nationwide lack of affordable and safe housing options. To help identify meaningful strategies in their community, the City of Dubuque asked IISC and its students to create an affordable housing action plan as part of our yearlong partnership.

While the city has produced multiple recent reports regarding housing, it does not have an action plan focused solely on affordable housing. A team of four graduate students—Hannah Lyons, Ethan Wherry, Gabin Kundwa, and Kaylynn Sieverding—began collaborating with city officials and community stakeholders last fall to create a comprehensive document they hope will provide Dubuque with direct actions to implement over the next five years. They will present their work at the IISC-Dubuque Closing Event on May 2. we invite you to spend some time with this site which provides a sense of the impact UI students and faculty can make on an lowa community.

In 2020-21, IISC completed 14 projects for Manchester, which involved seven UI departments. Projects ranged from a watershed management plan to school district marketing. The StoryMap highlights the many positive outcomes from the partnership, including the installation of a sculpture and external funding Manchester obtained to realize projects initiated by IISC students.

As Manchester's City Manager Tim Vick says, "We have done so many of the projects the IISC team helped us develop. The City of Manchester has truly benefited from this partnership."
